

**Recycling Committee Meeting**  
**Second Floor/Borough Building/ 6 PM**  
**February 6, 2007**

Attending: Glenda Boyer, Diane Hollinger, Cese Viti, and Council members Charlie Ryder and John McDermott

The Committee reviewed the recycling ad to be placed in the MASH spring musical program.

Glenda reported on her survey of sample recycling efforts of borough residents. The most frequently encountered non-compliance issues are

- \*placing newspapers in plastic bags rather than in paper bags
- \*putting cardboard in with the refuse
- \*not recycling magazines, catalogues, phonebooks and the like

Ideas to improve the situation are

- \*place door hangers with recycling info on doors of non-compliers
- \*on a paper bag, print list of paper items that can be recycled and leave it on doorsteps of non-compliers
- \*stick a message on the trash cans of non-compliers (if the problem exists in an alley, and the surveyor cannot ascertain for certain the address of the non-complier)

Charlie Ryder knows of a church group of men who are looking for a town project. He will approach the group to see if they are interested in surveying trash efforts and handing out the door hangers as their project.

Charlie Ryder will also inquire about the cost of a recycling ad for the St. Joe's spring musical program. The ad would reach 1500 audience members, mostly borough residents.
