LOST AND FOUND

1. All articles turned into the admission counter are kept for a period of one week and then discarded.
2. The pool is not responsible for valuables left unattended.

ADMINISTRATION

The pool is administered by the Mechanicsburg Area Recreation Department in cooperation with the Mechanicsburg Borough.

POOL RULES AND POLICIES

1. Use of pool when no pool lifeguard is in attendance is strictly prohibited.
2. Pennsylvania law requires bathers to shower before entering the pool.
3. No person with a contagious rash or skin infection will be permitted into the pool area.
4. No diving into shallow water.
5. No breath holding for long periods of time under water.
6. Anyone not potty trained must wear swim diapers.
7. No Diapers/Swim Diapers in Olympic Pool.
8. Use of the wading pool is restricted to children, 4 years of age or younger.
9. Only US Coast Guard approved floatation devices may be permitted at the discretion of the manager.
10. No cutoff jeans, sweatshirts, or street clothes may be worn while swimming in the pool. A clean white t-shirt may be worn by any swimmer.
11. Obscene language and behavior are prohibited.
12. No one is permitted to smoke, consume or possess alcoholic beverages or weapons while in the pool area.
13. No glass products in the pool area.
14. The lifeguard may refuse a swimmer admission to any area of the pool if the swimmer does not exhibit sufficient skill to insure his or her safety.
15. Float line ropes and buoys in the pool are safety devices and are to be handled by swimmers only in case of an emergency.
16. The pool must be cleared for a safety check whenever the lifeguards blow their whistles at one time. The pool will be cleared hourly or at the discretion of the guards, depending upon the number of persons swimming, for the purpose to conduct a safety check. After the safety check, adults may take their children, ages 5 and younger, in the pool. The Olympic Pool is restricted to adults only during the safety check.
17. No loitering in the pool area dressed in street clothes.
18. Unless there is an emergency, no person shall talk to or otherwise distract the attention of the lifeguards while on the guard stands.
19. If first aid is needed, contact a lifeguard. Report all injuries to a lifeguard. Any problems should be reported to management immediately.
20. Anyone allowing another person to use their season pass may result in suspension of pool privileges.
21. Anyone willfully giving false information to obtain a season ticket will have their pool privileges suspended without a refund of money.
22. Pool privileges may be suspended or revoked for violation of the rules.
23. Any objectionable items or activities not included in these rules will be judged by the pool manager or assistant manager, this includes personal appearance.
24. The family plan is available for parent(s) and any of their unmarried children 22 years of age and under who are residing in the same household. Children under the age of 3 are free and not included in the family count. Cousins, nieces, nephews, grandparents, grandchildren, aunts, uncles, babysitters etc. are NOT eligible for inclusion in a family membership.
25. Due to low attendance, the manager on duty may close sections of the pool.
26. Outside food is not permitted within the pool area.
