Curbside Yard Waste Collection to Resume

Borough curbside yard waste collection for 2016 will begin on March 2nd. Residents are asked to call the Borough Office by noon on Tuesday to schedule pick up of materials for Wednesday. All materials should be bundled or in dumpable containers. Don't forget you can take yard waste to the Joint Compost Facility on West Church Road year around. Passes for the facility are available at the Borough and Silver Spring Township Offices. For \$10 per year residents can dispose of yard waste and be assured it will be recycled into tanbark. Residents can also take tanbark and leaf mulch for use in their yard and garden.

GET YOUR DOG LICENSES !

Cumberland County dog licenses are available now through April 30, 2015 at the Borough Office. Licenses are issued from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday and applications are available in the office. The cost is \$9.00 for male/female dogs, or \$7.00 if neutered/spayed. The Senior Citizen fee — a person 65 years old or older — or a person with disabilities — is \$7.00 male/female dogs or \$5.00 if neutered/spayed. Any dog three months of age or older must be licensed. Inquires may be made to the Borough office at 717-691-3310.
