

Recreation Board Meeting

Minutes

November 8, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Crobak followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present were Crobak, Weber, Wilkens, Lougee, Meck and McDermott. Also present was Councilman Stoner, Manger Ciecierski and Recreation Director Brown.

Guests: Eagle Scout Cedar Brill and David Brill. Cedar gave a presentation of his Eagle Scout project to plan and build a gag pit, which is a recreation game played in a corral style area. Cedar provided plans, drawings and basic rules of the game along with a color map of a suggested construction location. Costs are expected to be covered through grants, a GoFundMe page and donations and the ongoing maintenance is very minimal. Weber moved, second by Meck to approve the project subject to final placement approval from the Borough.

Minutes: Wilkens moved, second by McDermott to approve the minute from the October 2016 meeting. Approved.

Reports: Rec Brown reported on the youth basketball program still looking for coaches and the winter brochures are being created.
